Information Collected: - Here are the types of donor information that we collect and maintain:

- Contact information: name, organization/company, complete address, phone number, email address
- Donation information: amounts donated, date of donation(s), method and stimulus

How Information is Used.

- The Diabetes Foundation of Mississippi uses donor data to maintain records of donations; send acknowledgements; send newsletters, notices, and direct mail pieces.
- We normally add donors to our mailing list, unless you request otherwise. Our thirdparty mailing service is contractually obligated to the lists with confidentially and is prohibited from transferring them elsewhere.
- We do NOT list individuals' names in ANY of our publications. Corporate and Foundation sponsors are listed in our Annual Report and event programs.
- We use donor's written comments/letters occasionally to post on our website (in an anonymous fashion), and to respond to your inquiries.
- Credit card numbers are NOT retained once processed. Our website has a SSL certificate.

No Sharing of Personal Information. The Diabetes Foundation of Mississippi will not sell, rent, trade or transfer your personal information with any other entity, nor send mailings to our DFM donors on behalf of other organizations. This policy applies to all information received by the, both online and offline, on any Platform (includes the DFM website), as well as any electronic, written, or oral communication. **Nevertheless**, security measures may not prevent all losses, and DFM is not responsible for any damages or liabilities relating to security failures.
